Purpose

To provide ongoing care for rescued animals, including cleaning, feeding and rehabilitation.

Key Responsibilities

Animal Rehabilitation and ongoing care

- Daily feeding and watering schedules.
- Cleaning and maintaining animal housing, bedding and yards.
- Monitoring health and wellbeing.
- Assisting with all aspects of animal care, health and rehabilitation.
- Assist with sanctuary maintenance and repair activities.

Other duties

- Supervise sanctuary volunteers.
- Maintaining a safe environment for animals, staff, volunteers and visitors by following biosecurity, emergency and safety procedures.
- Assist with events, tours and outreach as required.
- Occasional travel may be required for animal transport and general errands.

- Other duties as required.
- Provide fortnightly reports to committee on current projects in progress and/or completed work.
